Enhance Spa Bath Blower

Congratulations on the purchase of your new Enhance Spa Blower. The Enhance Spa Blower has been specifically designed for spa bath applications to ensure that you have optimum Air Jet performance and many years of trouble free operation.

Please read the installation instructions carefully before installing your Enhance Spa Blower, failure to do so may void your warranty.

Enhance Spa Blower - Spa Bath Installation:

- To ensure optimum performance your Enhance Spa Blower should be located as close as possible to your spa bath. To ensure high efficiency of your Enhance Spa Blower, we recommend that the spa blower be installed not exceeding 4 metres.
- 2. The Enhance Spa Blower can be located internally or externally. If you are fitting the Enhance Spa Blower externally, you must fit an Enhance Spa Blower Silencer (part# 3800) to meet IPX5 Electrical regulations (see page 5).
- 3. Internal installation must have adequate ventilation (minimum area 100cm²), inadequate ventilation may cause the motor to overheat and cut out on thermal over load.
- 4. Install the Enhance Spa Blower as per diagram 1 or diagram 2 for internal installation and diagram 3 for external installation. It is most important that the blower loop be a minimum of 200mm above the level of the bath as per diagram 1 and the double loop installed as per diagram 2 for under the hob installations failure to meet these requirements will void your warranty.
- 5. The Enhance Spa Blower should never be installed as shown in diagram 4 or diagram 5.
- 6. The Enhance Spa Blower is to be fixed to the frame or support through the blower mounting points in the blower base (refer Diagram 6) with appropriate fasteners.
- 7. Barrel unions only require to be hand tightened, over tightening may cause damage to the unions and or o rings. **Do not use stillsons or any other mechanical leverage.**
- 8. <u>Before connecting the Enhance Spa Blower to the pipe work, ensure that all glued fittings are allowed to dry and vent to atmosphere for 24 hours. Failure to vent the pipe work may cause serious injury or installation failure.</u> Check that the pipe work is clear of any debris as small particles that can cause blockage to the air jets or manifolds.
- 9. Installation of the Enhance Spa Blower must have access for servicing the blower or pipe work. Service access panel must be provided for every installation.

WARNING



Ensure that all glued fittings and pipe work are allowed to dry and that the glue vapour is allowed to vent to the atmosphere for a minimum of 24 hours before closing the installation. Failure to do so could cause serious injury or damage to the product.

Air Tube Connection "Enhance Spa Blower" (refer diagram 7)

- 1. Supplied with your spa blower is a 4 metre roll of 3mm clear air tube, fit one end of the air tube to the air button (supplied with the spa bath) on the spa bath.
- Uncoil the air tube so that you can connect it to the air switch located on the Enhance Spa Blower, the air tube connection is located just above the mounting bracket (refer diagram 7).
- Cut off excess tube and ensure that the tube is not kinked, do not wrap or loop excess tube around frame work of the bath or pipe work as this may cause the air button not to operate correctly.


Touch Pad Connection "Enhance Spa Blower" (refer diagram 8)

- 1. Supplied with your spa blower is a 4 metre touch pad cable, one end of this cable may be already fitted to the touch pad on your spa bath or it may be inside the blower carton.
- 2. Remove the rubber plug to access the touch pad connection point on the spa blower this is located just above the mounting bracket (refer diagram 8).
- 3. Connect the other end of the cable (with rubber cap) into the Enhance Spa Blower and push the connector into the housing until it "clicks" into the fixed position
- 4. Push the protective rubber cap on the touch pad cable over the circular housing.
- 5. It is important to ensure that the rubber cap is installed correctly (as per diagram 8) failure to do so will void the warranty.


Electrical Connection Enhance Spa Blower

- Enhance Spa Blower must be fitted in accordance with the relevant national wiring rules and electrical standards, particularly AS/NZS 3000 Section 7 or equivalent. In accordance with this requirement all Spa Blower installations must be protected by a residual-current device with maximum rated residual current of 30 mA.
- 2. The Enhance Spa Blower is fitted with a standard lead and three pin plug for 240-220V 50Hz power supply.
- 3. The Enhance Spa Blower power connection must be accessible so that it can be independently switched off in case of an emergency but must not be accessible by the bath user.
- 4. If damage occurs to the power cord it must be replaced by Edgetec or an authorised service agent or suitably qualified person

Enhance Blower Cover (shown below) MUST BE fitted to ALL EXTERNAL INSALLATIONS to comply with IPX5 Electrical Regulations





Enhance Spa Blower Silencer Cover (Part #3800) must be fitted to all external installations to meet IPX5 Electrical regulations.





INCORRECT SPA BLOWER INSTALLATION






AUTOMATIC AIR PRESSURE RELIEF VALVE

If the Enhance spa blower is installed on a reduced number of air injectors (less than 20), the air relief valve may open automatically and release any back pressure on the spa blower motor. The expelled air will be released through the barb fitting; this barb fitting does not require any hose to be fitted.

The Enhance Spa Blower Mounting uses a moulded rubber anti vibration pad. This pad features 4 T inserts through which the mounting screws are fitted. For maximum vibration isolation - these T inserts must be used in the mounting.







The Vibration Isolation Pad – with T Inserts can be removed from the blower and used as a template for drilling holes for mounting screws.


Note: If the blower is mounted close to a wall - or the rear screws are hidden behind the blower, fit the two rear screws to the antivibration pad as shown, then slide the blower into position on the pad, and then fit the two front screws. This makes installation very easy.

Spa Blower Installation - Internal Mounting

- 1. Select position for Spa Blower
- 2. Carefully Position Mounting Screw Holes to Contact solid timber or bricks
- 3. Remove T Slots Inserts from Blower Mounting Base
- 4. Remove Anti Vibration Pad this can be used as template for marking out Mounting Screw Position





- 5. Refit Anti Vibration Pad to Spa Blower
- 6. Replace T Slot Inserts (These provide vibration isolation between Spa Blower and Mounting Surface)
- 7. Mount Spa Blower using #8 X 30 self-tapping Screws (not Supplied)


Handy Hint: If mounting Spa Blower in difficult access against a wall.

- 1. Fit the Innermost screws first
- 2. Then slide the Spa Blower onto the Anti-Vibration Pad.
- 3. Bend the Anti-Vibration Pad into the Spa Blower Mount Foot
- 4. Insert the T Slot Inserts
- 5. Fit the Front 2 screws and tighten.



Spa Blower Installation - External Mounting

- 1. Select position for Spa Blower
- 2. Carefully Position Mounting Screw Holes to Contact solid timber or bricks
- 3. Remove T Slots Inserts from Blower Mounting Base
- 4. Remove Anti Vibration Pad this can be used as template for marking out Mounting Screw Position



- 5. Refit Anti Vibration Pad to Spa Blower
- 6. Replace T Slot Inserts (These provide vibration isolation between Spa Blower and Mounting Surface)
- 7. Fit the Spa Blower Inside Silencer Backplate
- 8. Mount Spa Blower using #8 X 30 selftapping Screws (not Supplied)
- 9. Important: Before fitting the front cover ensure that the power lead, air tube or touch pad cable are in the correct position and will not be crushed or kinked when fitting the front cover.
- 10. Slide Silencer Cover over top of Spa Blower and fit into top of Silencer Backplate
- 11. Secure Cover with 2 off #8 X 12 self-tapping Screws (Supplied)


Air Switch Model:

- When power is switched on for the first time the blower will purge for approximately 1 second to indicate that power is connected and the unit is ready for use.
- The air switch model is operated from the air button located on your spa bath.
- Press the air button to start the Enhance Spa Blower on high.
- Second press is medium speed.
- Third press is low speed.
- Fourth press the blower is in wave motion, varying the speed from low to high.
- Fifth press and the system will turn off.
- All enhance spa blowers will run for a maximum time of 30 minutes. To restart press the button again.

Sanitation Cycle:

 All Enhance Spa Blowers are fitted with a sanitation cycle. After the system has been turned off via the air button the Enhance Spa Blower will automatically turn itself on after 10 minutes and run on low speed for 15 seconds. This ensures that any excess water in the air lines or air jets is removed. Please note: should the sanitation cycle come on while you are still bathing, simply switch the blower back on when you exit the bath to reset the sanitation cycle.





- The Eezi Air model is operated from the Eezi Air Touch Pad.
- Press the touch pad to start the Enhance Spa Blower on high.
- Second press is medium speed.
- Third press is low speed.
- Fourth press the blower is in wave motion, varying the speed from low to high.
- Fifth press and the system will turn off.
- All enhance spa blowers will run for a maximum time of 30 minutes. To restart press the touch pad again.

Sanitation Cycle:

• All Enhance Spa Blowers are fitted with a sanitation cycle. After the system has been turned off via the touch pad the Enhance Spa Blower will automatically turn itself on after 10 minutes and run on low speed for 15 seconds. This ensures that any excess water in the air lines or air jets is removed. Please note: should the sanitation cycle come on while you are still bathing, simply switch the blower back on when you exit the bath to reset the sanitation cycle.





Sensa Touch Model:

- When power is switched on for the first time the blower will purge for approximately 1second to indicate that power is connected and the unit is ready for use.
- The Sensa Touch model is operated from the Sensa Touch Pad.
- Press the Sensa Touch middle button (Air) to start the Enhance Spa Blower on high.
- Second press is medium speed.
- Third press is low speed.
- Fourth press the blower is in wave motion, varying the speed from low to high.
- Fifth press and the system will turn off.
- All enhance spa blowers will run for a maximum time of 30 minutes. To restart press the touch pad again.

Sanitation Cycle:

All Enhance Spa Blowers are fitted with a sanitation cycle. After the system has been turned off via the Sensa Touch keypad the Enhance Spa Blower will automatically turn itself on after 10 minutes and run on low speed for 15 seconds. This ensures that any excess water in the air lines or air jets is removed. Please note: should the sanitation cycle come on while you are still bathing, simply switch the blower back on when you exit the bath to reset the sanitation cycle.



Spa-Key Model:

- When power is switched ON and after approximately 15 seconds the blower will purge for approximately 1second to indicate that power is connected and the unit is ready for use.
- The Spa Key model is operated from the Spa Key hand set button (colour Blue) third button down (labelled Air) on the hand set.
- Press the Spa Key "Air" button to start the Enhance Spa Blower on high.
- Second press is medium speed.
- Third press is low speed.
- Fourth press the blower is in wave motion, varying the speed from low to high.
- Fifth press and the system will turn off.
- All enhance spa blowers will run for a maximum time of 30 minutes. To restart press the touch pad again.

Sanitation Cycle:

- All Enhance Spa Blowers are fitted with a sanitation cycle. After the system has been turned off via the Spa Key "Air" button the Enhance Spa Blower will automatically turn itself on after 10 minutes and run on low speed for 15 seconds. This ensures that any excess water in the air lines or air jets is removed. Please note: should the sanitation cycle come on while you are still bathing, simply switch the blower back on when you exit the bath to reset the sanitation cycle.
- **Hand Set:** Your hand set that is provided with your system has already been synchronised during assembly and is ready to use.
- Extra or Replacement Hand Set. Can be synchronised by switching the power off to the unit and then back on, and pressing any "Button" on the SPA-KEY handset within 15 seconds, this will synchronise the handset. Refer to www.spakey.com.au for further technical information.


Start Up

- 1. Check all connections and pipes to ensure that they are glued and connected.
- 2. Air Switch Models-ensure that the air hose is connected from the air button to the spa blower (see diagram 7 page 7)..
- 3. Touch Pad Models-ensure that the cable supplied is connected to the touch pad and to the control box. Ensure that the rubber cap is fitted over the circular housing (see diagram 8 page 7).
- 4. Check that the air jet connection hoses are correctly fitted to all the air jet elbows and manifold barbs.
- 5. Ensure that the air hoses connected to the air jets have not been kinked or squashed during installation.
- 6. Ensure that the air jets are free from debris like tile grout or plaster.
- 7. Fill the spa bath and check for leaks in the air jet hoses and pipe work.

<u>Trouble Shooting Guide "Air Button"</u>

Symptom	Possible Cause	Remedy	
Enhance Spa Blower will not start	Air tube is not connected	Check to ensure that the air tube is connected from the air button to the spa blower (see diagram 7 page 7).	
	Air Tube is kinked	Check to ensure that the air tube is not kinked or wrapped around the frame work as this can stop the pulse of air required to come from the air button	
	Air Tube is too long	Reduce any excess tube length that is not required.	
	Air button not operating	Check to ensure that the air button is clear of debris (i.e. tile grout or plaster) and that the air button plunger moves freely	
	Mains Power to Enhance Spa Blower is not switched on	Check that the power point is in the "on" position and check that there is active power at the point	
	Water damage in the blower	Check to see if the blower is fitted in accordance with the installation instructions, rectify if incorrect. Water damage is not covered by warranty, replace blower with new unit	
	Worn motor brushes	Due to normal operation the brushes will wear and require replacing	
	Faulty Air switch	Contact service technician

Enhance Spa Blower will not	Mains Power to Enhance Spa Blower is not switched on	Check that the power point is in the "on" position and check that there is active power at the point
start	Water damage in the blower	Check to see if the blower is fitted in accordance with the installation instructions, rectify if incorrect. Water damage is not covered by warranty, replace blower with new unit
	Worn motor brushes	Due to normal operation the brushes will wear and require replacing

<u>Trouble Shooting Guide "Spa-Key"</u>

Symptom	Possible Cause	Remedy
	Mains Power to Enhance Spa Blower is not switched on	Check that the power point is in the "on" position and check that there is active power at the point
	Batteries are flat or not installed in Hand Set	Check to ensure that the batteries are installed in your hand set or press any button on the hand set, if the Red indicator lights up then the batteries are not flat. If the battery is flat replace the battery (A23 Battery). You do not have to re synchronize the hand set when replacing the battery
Enhance Spa Blower		To synchronize a new hand set, switch
will not start		"OFF" the power supply to the unit
www.spakey.com.au	Hand set is not synchronized with the Enhance Spa Blower control box	and then back "ON", and press any KEY on the SPA-KEY handset within 15 seconds, this will synchronise the handset to the blower, refer www.spakey.com.au for further technical information
